Schultz, Mrs. Florence E., of Frankenmuth, Michigan passed away on Saturday, February 4, 2012, at the Lutheran Home of Frankenmuth. Age 99 years. Florence E. Hildner was born on April 23, 1912, in Frankenmuth, to the late Leonard G. and Johanna (Ranzenberger) Hildner. She was married to Paul E. Schultz on October 21, 1961. He predeceased her on May 3, 1985. Prior to her retirement in 1977, Florence was employed by Metropolitan Life Ins. since 1960 in Ann Arbor, Saginaw and Bay City. She was a member of Holy Cross Ev. Lutheran Church and its Altar Guild, the L.F.A., Valparaiso Guild, and volunteered at St. Luke's and Bethesda. At the Lutheran Home, Florence actively participated in their many outings and activates, including a Detroit Tigers baseball game at Comerica Park last August at age 99. Her crochet covered coat hangers became a popular item for sale in the Lutheran Home gift store the past three years. Florence is survived by her step-son, Paul (Gloria) Schultz, Midland; five grandchildren; three great-grandchildren; also many nieces and nephews, including Lois Wylie, Richard (Mary Ann) Krafft, Ronald (Donna) Hildner, and Edward (Sue) Hildner, all of Michigan, as well as other nephews in Indiana, Connecticut, and Florida.
