Passed away unexpectedly on Monday, April 4, 2016, at home. Age 58 years. Kay was born on April 2, 1958, in Saginaw to James C. and Arla M. (Robertson) Basner. She was employed by Kessler Environmental Excavating as an accountant. She loved playing the French Horn in the Classic Legacy Band and for worship at Faith, St. John and Resurrection Lutheran Churches in Saginaw. Kay was a member of Faith Lutheran Church and was active within the Lutheran Via de Cristo of Central Michigan. Kay held a Bachelor Degree in Accounting from Central Michigan University, and was a graduate of Bridgeport High School.
