Passed away on Thursday, May 1, 2014, at Edgewood Assisted Living Center. Age 90 years. Alma Marie Williams was born on March 18, 1924, in Arnold, PA to the late David LeRoy and Martha (Daft) Williams. She was married to Dr. Richard H. Gilmore on February 6, 1946, in Erie, PA. He predeceased her on February 11, 1996. She then married Howard R. Doud on May 4, 1997, in Pinehurst, NC, and he predeceased her on October 16, 2001.

Alma was a member of the Saginaw Twp Rotary Club, and Navy League, the Foundation for the Naval War College on Newport, RI, a former active member of the Junior League of Saginaw, Life Member of the Saginaw General Hospital Auxiliary, the Jameson Memorial Hospital Auxiliary, Girl Scout Council, National Farm and Garden of Club of Saginaw, Life Member of the Saginaw Country Club, the Saginaw Country Club Ladies Golf Assoc., Program Chair of the Saginaw Dental Auxiliary, Michigan State Dental Board Auxiliary, St. Mary's Children's Free Ward Auxiliary, Saginaw Co. husband established the Gilmore-Williams Fund.

Scott (Victoria) Gilmore, Saginaw; two granddaughters, Nichole (Jason) Bordeau, West Olive, MI, Melissa Gilmore, Winter Haven, FL; five great-grandchildren, Cassandra, Alexia, Brooklyn, and Dakota Bordeau and Kyle Gilmore; one brother, Edward (Sally) Williams, Naples, FL; and many nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by two brothers, Dr. Robert E. Williams and John H. Williams.

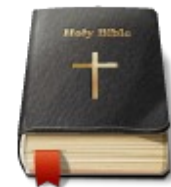
