Al passed away on Tuesday, February 14, 2023, at the Aleda E. Lutz, V.A. Medical Center, Saginaw, MI, at the age of 91 years. Alvin Donald McGregor was born on October 1, 1931, in Dawson Springs, Kentucky, to the late James and Virginia (Clayton) McGregor. A.D. was married to Shirley Ann Hopkins on March 22, 1952. Having celebrated 66 years of marriage, Shirley predeceased Al on September 26, 2018.

Their union was blessed with a son, Al (Debra) McGregor; his grandchildren, Nicole Elaine, Michael Joseph, and Shawn David; his great-grandson, Seth Allen; his brother and sister-in-law, Earl (Kay) McGregor; his sister, Mary Ann Badour; in-laws, Bette Lou (Larry) Brabant; nephew and nieces, Kevin, Janelle and Sharilyn; also extended family members and dear friends.

Alvin, Airman 3rd class, served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War. Prior to his retirement, Alvin was employed with the Singer Sewing Machines as a repairman for 55 years.
