Andrew Smith passed away peacefully on Monday, January 31, 2022, at home, while his family was at his side. He was 81 years of age. Andrew was born on August 27, 1940, in Bad Axe, Michigan to the late Archibald and Augusta (McPhee) Smith. He married Carol A. (Brown) Smith on August 13, 1966, Skidway Lake, Michigan. She survives him. Andrew is also survived by his children, David (Terri) Smith, Deborah (Steven) Plummer, Donald (Christina) Smith; his grandchildren, Karlee Cassiday, Lucas (Jasmine) Smith, Christopher (Kallai) Plummer, Micheal (Taylor) Plummer and Adalyn Smith; two great-grandchildren and expecting a 3rd in July; his brother, Alexander Smith; sister-in-law, Kathy Smith; many nieces, nephews, extended families and dear friends. Besides his parents, Andrew was predeceased by his granddaughter, Emily Plummer and his brother, A. John Smith.

Andrew served in the United States Navy, during the Vietnam War. He was stationed aboard the USS Ozbourn, while in the Pacific.

Prior to his retirement, Andrew was employed with Nelson Electric, through IBEW Local 557, having recently received an award for his 55 years of

service. Andrew enjoyed spending time with his family, especially while fishing, hunting and square dancing. He was a long-time member of Second Presbyterian Church and a life-member of the St. Charles American Legion Post #468.

Andrew's funeral service will take place at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 5, 2022, at Second Presbyterian Church, 2665 Midland Road, Saginaw, MI. The Rev. Philomena Ofori-Nipaah will officiate. Friends are welcome to visit with the family at the church on Saturday from 11:00 a.m. until the time of service.
