Betty passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, December 19, 2021, at the age of 81 years. Betty Lou Dengler was born on January 24, 1940, in Saginaw County, to the late Henry and Pearl (Spaeth) Dengler. She married Darald Wallace, divorcing him and then married Donald Bamberg on October 1, 1982, he predeceased her on November 25, 1987. Betty had been a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church since 1945, having attended its grade school from the 4th to 8th grades. She graduated from Saginaw High School and received her Associates degree in Liberal Arts from Delta College. Betty taught Sunday school, Vacation Bible School, held many offices, serving on many committees and sang in the choir at Redeemer. She transferred her membership to Messiah Lutheran Church in 2013. Betty volunteered at Bethesda Thrift Store, made sandwiches for the West Side Soup Kitchen, and was President of the LCFS Auxiliary – Saginaw Chapter. Prior to her retirement in 1992, Betty was employed by General Motors at Saginaw Steering Gear in the accounting department for 29.5 years.

She leaves this world to join Jesus and her special angels, her son, Corey Wallace, who predeceased her on September 17, 2006, her parents, Henry

and Pearl Dengler, her husband, Donald Bamberg, her sisters, Darlene and Gaylord Gidley and Janice Glazier, her nieces, Gretchen Gidley and Michelle Gidley.
