Campbell, Charles D. of Swan Creek, Twp., passed away Saturday, February 20, 2010, at Hoyt Nursing and Rehab Centre. Age 86 years. Charles was born on December 21, 1923, in Springfield, Missouri to the late Tillman and Zeda (Finney) Campbell. He married Virginia E. Osborn on June 23, 1951. She predeceased him on August 25, 1986. 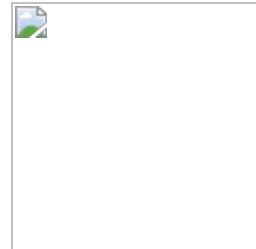
