Mr. Clarence Jacob Hemminger went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, September 24, 2018, from Wellspring - Meadowview Manor, at the age of 102 years. Clarence was born on March 1, 1916, in Oconto Falls, Wisconsin, to the late Jacob and Christina (Wesner) Hemminger. Clarence moved to Chicago, Illinois following graduation from high school. Prior to his retirement, he was employed as an accountant in the Tool & Die manufacturing industry until 1981. Clarence served in the United States Army during WWII. He then married Meta Moeller on October 25, 1942. After 72 years of marriage, Meta predeceased Clarence on August 17, 2015. Their marriage was blessed with two sons, Dale (Dianne) Hemminger of Belle Fourche, South Dakota and Alan (Carole) Hemminger of Rockford, Michigan; also five grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

Clarence was a member of St. James Lutheran Church in Chicago, IL, Zion Lutheran Church in Lyons, IL, and Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Saginaw, MI.

The Celebration of Clarence's Life will be held 11:00 a.m. Friday, October 5, 2018, at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, 5335 Brockway Road, Saginaw

Twp, MI. The Rev. Paul Biber will officiate. Clarence and Meta will be laid to rest together in Fairview Memorial Park Cemetery in Northlake, Illinois.
