A loving husband, father, grandfather, brother, veteran and friend passed away on Friday, August 30, 2019, at Covenant Medical Center – Harrison, at the age of 80 years. Dale Louis Stevens was born on May 10, 1939 in West Branch, Michigan to the late Forest and Iva (Killingbeck) Stevens. Dale was a 1957 graduate of Rose City High School. He enlisted in the United States Army at Ft. Sill, OK and served in the Vietnam War. He was honorably discharged on July 3, 1972, while stationed at Ft. Dix, NJ after serving 13 years. Dale later served an additional 7 years in the Army National Guard.

Prior to his retirement, Dale was employed with the United States Postal Service as a mail carrier for 35 years. Dale married Sandra Lee Gilman in October, 1981, in Saginaw, where she survives him. Dale's hobbies and past-times included hunting, fishing, camping, fixing anything he could find to fix, and making friends with everyone who crossed his path.
