Archambeau on July 7, 1956. They had celebrated 62 years of marriage before Otto predeceased her on February 24, 2017.

She was a full-time homemaker and mother. She had been active in several volunteer organizations, including the American Red Cross, Bethesda Lutheran Home Auxiliary and many organizations within Redeemer Lutheran Church, where she was a lifelong member before transferring to Faith Lutheran Church in Bridgeport.

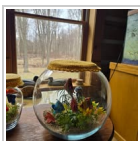
