Passed away on Tuesday, October 3, 2017, at the Bavarian Comfort Care, Bridgeport. Age 93 years. Edward Harold Meyer was born on February 26, 1924, in Saginaw, to the late Edward and Mary (Gardyko) Meyer. On January 25, 1947, Ed married Frances Dorothy Dutcher, and after 70 years of marriage, Frances predeceased him on March 4, 2017.

S/Sgt. Edward Meyer served in the United States Army during WWII in the Asiatic Pacific Theater, awarded 2 Bronze Battles Stars; Philippine Liberation Ribbon with 1 Battle Star;

2 Overseas Service Bars, and was a recipient of the Purple Heart. He was honorably discharged on January 24, 1946. Upon his return back home, Ed entered into the insurance and real estate business, where he eventually owned, operated and was President of the Edward Meyer & Son, Inc. and Real Estate Broker. He also developed Meyer Subdivision and Bay Wood Acres 2 & 3, where he built many spec homes in his subdivision. Ed's memberships were many, he had been very active within the West Side Lions Club, West Side Kiwanis, member and past President of the Saginaw Board of Realtors, Coast Guard Auxiliary, and held many positions at churches in Saginaw, Pigeon, and Ft. Myers, FL; was also a member of the V.F.W.

Surviving are his son and daughter and their spouses, Tom (Kathy) Meyer, Vassar; Nancy (Dan) Maul, St. Charles; six grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren, and one great-great grandchild; his brother, James (Janice) Meyer, his sister, Betty (Leo) Boyd; his brother-in-law, Bill Kubik; also many nieces, nephews, extended family and dear friends.

Ed was predeceased by his sisters, Arvella Meyer and Gladys Kubik.

Ed was an incredibly kind, generous, patient man who was continually expanding his knowledge, hobbies and interests which included celestial navigation, sailing, power boating, RC airplane building and flying, stained glass and reading. He will always be remembered as a humble, patriotic, Christian man. A man to be emulated by all.
