Fechter on October 18, 1952, in Saginaw, and he predeceased her on June 29, 2006. She originally had been a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church, then became a member with Messiah Lutheran Church. Prior to her retirement, Eunice was employed as a secretary with the Buena Vista School District.
