Weess, Mr. Gerhard H., of Saginaw, Michigan. Beloved husband and father passed away Saturday, September 24, 2011, after a courageous battle with cancer surrounded by his family. Age 82 years. Gerhard was born on June 24, 1929, in Saginaw, to the late Henry F. and Mina (Hagner) Weess. He married Sallyann K. Alles on October 19, 1957. She predeceased him on August 25, 1993. Gerhard served in the U. S. Navy during the Korean War from 1951 - 1955. Prior to his retirement in 1986, he was employed by General Motors at Grey Iron and Nodular Iron foundries as a supervisor in industrial engineering. He was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, the American Legion, and the Washington Society. He enjoyed spending time with his family, especially at his cottage on Secord Lake.
