Kabobel, Gotto F. Saginaw, Michigan Gotto was called home to his Lord on Sunday morning, November 9, 2008. Age 92 years. Gotto was born on May 8, 1916 in Silverwood, Mich. to the late Alexander and Eva (Fromm) Kabobel. He was married to Ella Becker on April 4, 1937 in Saginaw, where she survives him. Gotto served in the U.S. Army during WWII. Prior to his retirement in 1980, Gotto was employed as a layout person at Baker Perkins for 44 years. He was a charter member of Resurrection Lutheran Church, having served on various boards. He was a longtime volunteer for Meals on Wheels, American Red Cross, and the Saginaw Township Parks and Recreation Dept. for 36 years. In recognition of his time with the parks, the area alongside Zauel Memorial Library was named Gotto's Playland in his honor. Gotto enjoyed reading and yard work. Surviving besides his wife, Ella, are their son Ronn Kabobel, Saginaw Twp.; two grandchildren; Kristine Kabobel, Saginaw; Aaron Kabobel, St. Clair Shores, Mich.; three great-grandchildren, Brooke (Russell) Purkiss, Joseph Spahr, Ronald Spahr; two great-great-grandchildren, Taylor Purkiss, Waylon Purkiss; and one brother, Edward (Margaret) Kabobel, Saginaw.
