



H. Kenneth Bartholomew Jr.

December 8, 1926 - July 7, 2019

Mr. Bartholomew passed away peacefully and walked into the arms of Jesus on Sunday, July 7, 2019, from Wellspring Lutheran Services in Frankenmuth, Michigan. Age 92 years. Ken was born on December 8, 1926, in Jackson County, Parma, Michigan, to the late H. Kenneth, Sr. and Florence (Robinson) Bartholomew. Seaman First Class, H. Kenneth Bartholomew enlisted in the United States Navy on November 16, 1944, and was honorably discharged on October 20, 1947, having served during WWII. He then was married to Joyce L. Savage on April 18, 1953, having celebrated 66 years together. Prior to his retirement, Ken was employed with Consumers Energy (Consumer Power) for 30 years as a tree trimmer and meter reader. Ken was a member of Immanuel Bible Church, he also was a member of the American Legion Post #150 in Frankenmuth, MI, having served on their Military Honor Guard detail for several years, he then was a past Commander of the V.F.W. Post #9931 in Bridgeport, MI. Ken's hobbies and pass-times included genealogy, gardening and patriotism.
