



Harold F. Burk Jr.

June 25, 1937 - April 30, 2024

Harold was called home to his Lord on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, from Bickford of Saginaw Twp. He was 86 years old. Harold Frederick Burk, Jr. was born on June 25, 1937, in Saginaw, son of the late Harold and Marion (Gutowski) Burk. Harold is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, serving as an aircraft mechanic from 1955 at Moody AFB, Valdosta, Georgia, until his honorable discharge on July 12, 1959. Harold married Judith J. (Genske) Burk on May 13, 1961, in Saginaw, where she survives him. During a 44 year working career and prior to his retirement in 1999, Harold excelled as a maintenance machinist for over two decades at Grey Iron Foundry, then as a machine repairman / mechanical tech. machinist for 10 years at General Motors Advanced Materials Development Center (AMDC). He served his machinist apprenticeship at Baker Perkins prior to his 33 year career at GM. Harold was a member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, and a supporter of the City Rescue Mission of Saginaw.

Surviving besides his wife, Judith, are their two sons and their spouses, Daniel (Laura) Burk of Bath, MI and Michael (Janelle) Burk of Byron Center, MI; Four grandsons, Roman, Lee, Austin and Jason Burk; two granddaughters, Julia (Josh) Bloom, and Dayna Burk; his brother, Benjamin R. (Maureen) Burk of Saginaw; his sisters, Ruth Ann Clark and Linda (Robert) Metzger. Harold was predeceased by his parents and his sister, Mary Ellen Schoonard, his brother in-law Howard Clark II, and his sister-in-law, Vikki

Burk.
