Loving wife, mother, sister, and grandmother passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, at Covenant Hospital, at the age of 83 years. Joyce (Clauss) Krogman was born on May 2, 1941, in Saginaw, Michigan to the late Adam Clauss, Jr. and Anna Margaret (Weigandt) Clauss. She graduated from Arthur Hill High School in 1959. Joyce was married to Norman A. Krogman on March 22, 1969, in Saginaw, Michigan. After 53 years of marriage, Norm predeceased her on May 6, 2022. She is survived by her children, Todd Clauss and Brenda (Jeff) Crook; and her grandchildren; Adam Clauss, Larissa Crook, and Jacob Crook.
