Bud was born on February 3, 1931, in Saginaw, to the late LeRoy, Sr. and Dorothy (Engel) Guttowsky. Bud married Lois C. Buehler on May 6, 1950, in Saginaw and shared 65 years of marriage together. She survives him. Prior to his retirement, Bud was employed at Fabiano Brothers for 30 years. Bud was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church and Teamsters Union #486 – Zilwaukee, Saginaw County Hall of Fame, and the Carrollton Athletic Association. Bud played minor league baseball in the Washington Senators farm system.
