NO ONE VISIT'S US NOONE PICKS UP A PHONE TO SAY I THOUGHT ABOUT YOU TODAY. WITHOUT ASKING FOR MONEY OR SOME OTHE TYPE OF NEED. WHEN I FIRST MOVE NEXT DOOR I'D SEE HER OUT SIDE IN HER YARD. WE'D TALK SOME TIME SHE TOLD ME TO CALL HER VIDA. SO NEVER ASK WHAT A PERSON NEED IS GOD SHARES THAT WITH ME. SO SHE'D WALK TO THE LOCAL STORE JUST TO BUY HERSELF A LITER POP. IF I WAS IN THE STORE I'D PAY FOR IT SHE'D SAY YOU DON'T HAVE TO PAY FOR MY POP. I'D SAY OH YES I'AM AND I'M GIVING YOU A RIDE HOME ALSO. MANY TIMES I'D SEE HER WAITING ON THE BUS. I'D BE LEAVING MY HOUSE I'D STOP AND BLOW MY HORN. I SAID VIDA I WILL GIVE YOU A RIDE O.K SHE'D SMILE. I NEVER ASK ABOUT ANOTHER PERSON BUSINESS IT'S JUST NOT MY PLACE. SO VIDA SHARED WITH ME HER HUSBAND PASSED. SHE LIVED ALONE GOD BLESSED ME WITH UNDERSTANDING. I ALREADY KNEW HER LIFE WITHOUT THAT TYPE OF CONVERSATION. I'AM A MISSIONARY WITHOUT A MISSION I ONLY FILL THAT VOID IN YOUR LIFE. IT'S CALLED JOY AND HAPPINESS SHORT TERM. A FEW TIMES SHE WENT TO THE BUS STATION DOWN TOWN. I ALWAYS GAVE HER 5 OR 10 DOLLARS NO MATTER IF IT WAS MY LAST. I WAS RAISED BY A SINGLE MOM WHO TAUGHT ME

TO MAKE DUE UNTIL I COULD DO BETTER. SHE WENT TO THE LIBRARY A COUPLE OF TIMES. SHE'D ALWAYS SAY THANK YOU YOUR'E A NICE LADY. VIDA NEVER KNEW AS I CONTINUED ON MY WAY I SHARED SOME THANKSGTEARS FOR HER. I'VE WALKED IN HER SHOES MANY TIMES I KNOW WHAT IT IS TO WANT AND NOT HAVE. SO ONE YEAR I WALKED OVER TO HER HOUSE. WENT UP THE STEPS AND KNOCKED ON HER DOOR. SHE ANSWERED I SAID VIDA WOULD YOU LIKE OR CAN YOU USE A COMPLETE THANKSGIVING DINNER. ONE WAS DONATED TO MY DAUGHTER BUT I HAD ALREADY BROUGHT DINNER FOR MY FAMILY. SHE STEPPED OUTSIDE HER DOOR AND SAID THANK YOU I DIDN'T HAVE MONEY TO BUY DINNER. SHE HUGGED ME I FELT HER ORA AND WE BOTH CRIED. SOMETIMES PERSONAL HAPPINESS IS NOT ALWAYS IN YOUR FAMILY. ONE CHRISTMAS I NOTICED TWO YOUNG CHILDREN AT HER HOME. GREY IRON DELIVERS CHRISTMAS DINNERS I GAVE THEM VIDA'S ADDRESS. I KNEW WHAT TIME HER FOOD BOX WOULD COME ONCE SHE RECIEVED HER GIFT FROM GOD. MY DAUGHTER BROUGHT ME A CHRISTMAS TREE AND ALL THE TRIMINGS. I TOOK TREE AND EVERYTHING ELSE ONCE AGAIN TO HER HOME. WE CRIED SAME RESPONCE YOU SHOULD BE GOOD TO YOURSELF EVERDAY BECAUSE THE NEXT DAY ISN'T PROMISED. I WANT TO SHARE THE LAST TIME I SAW VIDA SHE WAS IN AN ELEVATOR AT COVENANT HARRISON. MY HUSBAND AND I WALKED INTO IT TO RIDE TO THE 7TH FLOOR. MY MOTHER WAS INTO TO HER LAST STAGE OF LIVER CANCER. I WENT TO THAT HOSPITAL 17 DAYS TOTAL 4 TO 5 HOURS EVERY DAY. UNTIL SHE PASSED MARCH 17TH 2015. YOU CAN NEVER LABOR TOO MUCH FOR SOMEONE YOU TRUELY LOVE. MY MOM WAS THE 3RD IMPORTANT FAMILY MEMBER I TRANSITIONED TO GOD'S CRADDLING ARMS. MY GRANDFATHER IN 1975 AND MY GRANDMOTHER WAS IN ICU I WATCHED AS GOD SLOWLY ERASING THE LINES ON HER MONITOR SHE WAS 92 YEARS OLD. SHE STOP BREATHING WHILE I WAS TALKING TO HER. I WAS SITTING BESIDE HER BED WITH MY FACE LAYING ON

HER HAND. TELLING HER ABOUT THE FAMILY MEMBERS SHE WOULD BE REUNITED WITH. WHEN I SPOKE ABOUT THOSE GOOD OLD APPLES PIES SHE WILL BE BACKING FOR SOME ONE ELSE SHE FLAT LINED. I SAID WELL GRANDMA YOUR'E GONE I LOOKED AT THE CLOCK. I STOOD UP PLACED MY HEAD ON HER CHEST HER HEART WAS NO LONGER BEATING. AS VIDA LAID ON THAT HOSPITAL BED WITH A TUBE IN HER NOSE GASPING FOR AIR. WE NODDED
