Passed away on Tuesday, September 8, 2015, at Cartwright Hospice Residence. Age 87 years. Lois Elaine Jutzi was born on July 29, 1928, in Saginaw to the late Edward and Gertrude (Nowack) Jutzi. She married Edward J. Peitsch on November 12, 1949, in Saginaw. She worked at Standard Oil, Baker Perkins, in adult education, a teacher's aide and at McDonald's. She volunteered as a Sunday School teacher, Bethlehem Hot Lunch program, Cub Scout Den Mother, made quilts, choir robes, and costumes for the Boars Head Festival. She was a member of The American Guild of English Handbell Ringers.
