Marilyn was called home to eternal rest after a brief illness on Friday, September 2, 2016, at Covenant Medical Center – Harrison. Age 73 years. Marilyn Hetzner was born on December 1, 1942, in Saginaw, to the late Elmer G. and Mildred (Pacholke) Hetzner. She was united in marriage to Wayne T. Bloomfield on June 20, 1964, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Saginaw. He survives her. Marilyn graduated from Arthur Hill High School and worked at NABISCO shortly before devoting her time to raise her three children. An accomplished seamstress, she worked on her own and later for several bridal shops making and altering wedding gowns, dresses, and other clothes. She also kept the books for her husband's business, Wayne's Service Center in Saginaw. She also volunteered at Peace Lutheran Church and School, and cared for many children as a babysitter, which was one of her proudest accomplishments.

Surviving besides her husband, Wayne, are their three children and their spouses, Ron (Corrine) Bloomfield, Rebecca (Rod) Tomlinson, and Sarah (Adam) Rauner; "Mimi" to six grandchildren, Connor and Catherine Bloomfield, Aiden, Koby and Truman Rauner, and Gayle Tomlinson; also known as "Merm" to her siblings, sister, Janice (Norm) Sowatsky; brother,
