Mary Kathryn Campbell of Saginaw, Michigan, passed away peacefully on Monday, April 6, 2026, at the age of 87, while residing at Great Lakes Rehab Center.

A beloved mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend, Mary Kathryn “Kate” Bolger was born on November 28, 1938, in Saginaw, Michigan, the youngest of eight children born to the late Jacob and Martha (Poppeck) Bolger. She graduated from Saginaw High School in 1956.
