Loving husband, father, brother, and grandfather passed away unexpectedly on Friday, May 6, 2022, at his home, at the age of 81 years. Norman was born on January 4, 1941, in Saginaw, Michigan to the late Howard and Mary (Rilko) Krogman. Norm was married to Joyce (Clauss) Krogman on March 22, 1969 in Saginaw, Michigan. Joyce survives him. He is also survived by his children, Todd Clauss and Brenda (Jeff) Crook. Grandchildren, Adam Clauss, Larissa Crook and Jacob Crook.
