Passed away Friday, February 24, 2017, at St. Mary's of Michigan hospital after a long, brave fight with kidney disease. Age 82 years. Otto was born on July 15, 1934, in Saginaw, to the late Israel and Anna (Anklam) Archambeau. He married Delores M. Bingham on July 7, 1956, and celebrated 62 years together. She survives him. Prior to his retirement, Otto had worked in the Heating and Cooling business, Buena Vista Township, was a volunteer firefighter, and a Jack of all trades. He was a former longtime member of Redeemer Lutheran Church and transferred to Faith Lutheran Church, Bridgeport.

Surviving besides his wife, Delores, are three sons and their spouses, Craig (Kenda) Archambeau, William (Debbie) Archambeau, and Brian Archambeau; four grandchildren, Lindsey (Jacob) Rosenburg, Jonathon (Megan) Archambeau, Chelsea Archambeau and Jennifer Archambeau; three great-granddaughters, Lillian Mae, Rylee Sue and Margaret Anne; one sister, Dorothy Archambeau; and one brother, Cecil Archambeau.
