



Mr. Otto W. Bernreuter

September 9, 1928 - May 10, 2011

Bernreuter, Otto W., of Saginaw, Michigan, passed away on Tuesday, May 10, 2011, at Covenant Medical Center-Cooper. Age 82 years. He was the son of Otto G. and Florence D. (Riethmeier) Bernreuter and was born on September 9, 1928, in Blumfield Twp., near Gera. Otto served his country during the Korean War as a member of an amphibious engineering unit. Otto was employed at General Motors as a machine operator until 1954, when he was involved in a motorcycle accident, which left him permanently disabled. Otto volunteered at the Aleda E. Lutz – V.A. Medical Center, where he served a record-breaking number of volunteer hours. He was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church. Otto is survived by his brother and sister-in-law, Howard and Rosanne Bernreuter; three nephews, Van and Heidi Bernreuter; Hugh and Michele Bernreuter; Wade and Nikki Bernreuter.

Funeral service will take place 11:00 a.m., Saturday, May 14, 2011, at the Wakeman Funeral Home, Inc., 1218 N. Michigan Ave. The Rev. Charles F. Buckhahn will officiate with burial in St. Michael's Lutheran Cemetery in Richville, with military honor guard under the auspices of American Legion Post #22.
