You should know that this classroom was an absolute godsend for me, and the gentle and kind Ms Stroebel was a beacon of peace in my world. I was a smart kid and school was my refuge from an abusive and stressful home life, and the CAT classroom specifically was where I was happiest. She was a true teacher, teaching children how to think critically about the world and activate their creative problem-solving skills.

I have gone on to graduate school in depth psychotherapy and have moved even to the most progressive edge of that profession, Neurolinguistic Programming and coaching people how to live at their peak levels of fulfillment.

This classroom was the most nourishing thing in my life from ages 8-10. It is truly profound what an impact a teacher can have on the rest of a person's life.
