Paul Meyer was called home to his Lord on Thursday, November 7, 2024, from Edgewood Assisted Living in Saginaw Township. Age 94 years. Paul Edward Meyer was born on February 6, 1930, in Holgate, Ohio, to the late Paul Sr. and Dorothy (Badenhop) Meyer. Upon graduation from high school Paul served in the United States Air Force during the Korean War, and was honorably discharged in 1954. Paul married Mary Lois Scholl on January 1, 1954, in Deshler, Ohio. She predeceased him on August 26, 2024. Following his service in the United States Air Force, Paul attended Defiance College fulltime and also was employed by General Motors fulltime. Upon graduation, General Motors moved the family to Saginaw. He retired in 1990 with 37 years of service in finance.

He was a faithful member of Holy Cross Lutheran Church, where he and Mary treasured their friendships with staff and members for nearly 70 years. Paul served on many different boards, including finance, stewardship and outreach, and congregational president. He was very active with the school there and served on the committee that built the new school in 1970. He spent many years on the cemetery board working hard helping to maintain and beautify the grounds. Paul and Mary were also blessed with many years of Christian

fellowship with dear friends at their residence at the Coach House Park in Palmetto, Fl. While there, Paul played golf, shuffleboard, darts, cards, and truly enjoyed his golden years.

The family would like to especially thank the entire staffs at Edgewood Assisted Living Center and Careline Hospice for their kind and gentle care of our father. Our thanks also to Holy Cross for their faithful prayers, visitation and witness during our dad's illness.
