



Mr. Reinhold "Reinie" Laubhan

January 28, 1926 - September 20, 2011

Laubhan, Mr. Reinhold (Reinie), of Saginaw, Michigan, passed away Tuesday, September 20, 2011, at Caretel Inns of Tri-Cities. Age 85 years. Reinie was born on January 28, 1926, in Saginaw to the late Fred and Amelia (Reisig) Laubhan. He was stationed in Italy while serving in the US Army during WWII. Reinie married Vivian A. Finger on October 23, 1946. She survives him. He was employed with Standard Oil Co., Interstate Motor, Great Lakes Express and Roadway Express, retiring in 1982. He was a past member of the Teamsters Union #486, serving as its president in 1965. Surviving besides his wife, Vivian, are their four children and their spouses, John (Laura) Laubhan, Suttons Bay; Tom (Kellie) Laubhan, Ft. Wayne, IN; Paul (Julie) Laubhan, Grand Rapids; Ann Leggitt, Saginaw; nine grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; one sister, Molly Fetting; one brother, Robert Laubhan, all of Saginaw. He was predeceased by five brothers, David, Fred, Edward, Charles, and Alex Laubhan, and one sister, Mary Lentner.

Funeral service will take place 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, September 27, 2011, at Bethlehem Lutheran Church, 808 Weiss St. The Rev. Michael R. Korte will officiate with burial in Oakwood Cemetery.
