Richard C. Rosa passed away on Sunday morning, June 27, 2021, at his home, surrounded by his loving family, at the age of 91 years. Richard was born on May 1, 1930, in Detroit, Michigan, to the late Lawrence and Ova (Hopkins) Rosa. Richard married Carol Mae Fischer on February 12, 1955, she survives him.
