Richard was called home to his Lord on Monday, October 9, 2017, at Covenant Emergency Care Center. Age 89 years. Richard Dale Fredrick Younk was born on July 16, 1928, in Saginaw, the youngest of seven children, to the late Frederick and Ludwicka (Novak) Younk. Richard served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War. Richard married Margaret M. Johnson on April 30, 1955, in Saginaw, which they shared 62 years together. She survives him. Prior to his retirement, he was employed as a diesel mechanic at Great Lakes Express and Waste Management. He was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church where he was very active with the Boars Head Festival for over 30 years. He was also a member of the American Legion Post 439.

Surviving besides his wife, Margaret, are their children, Margo Winieckie, Douglas (Ann) Younk, and Russell Younk, all of Saginaw; five grandchildren, Laura, Russell, II, Ryan, Amber and Joshua Younk; one great-grandchild, Kendall; and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a daughter, Lynn Whyte; three sisters, Frieda Younk, Esther Younk, and Emma Erat; and three brothers, William, Ernest and Theodore Younk.
