February 18, 1933 - December 25, 2010

Fanger, Robert C., of Bay City, Michigan, passed away on Christmas morning, December 25, 2010, at Hoyt Nursing & Rehab Centre. Age 77 years. Mr. Fanger was born on February 18, 1933, in Saginaw to the late Wilburt and Gertrude (Dombkowski) Fanger. He married Shirley Klein on April 26, 1952, and she survives him. Robert served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War in Pusan, and was honorably discharged in 1955. Prior to his retirement, he was employed at GM's Grey Iron Foundry for 27 years. He was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church and the American Foundry Society. 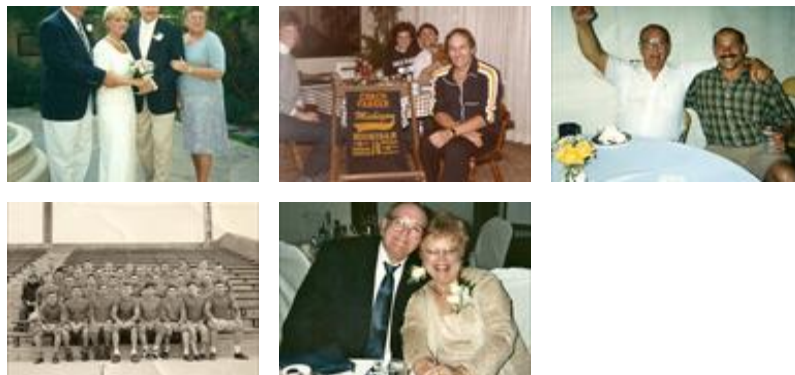
