Passed away Tuesday, May 15, 2012, at Covenant Medical Center - Cooper. Age 78 years. Robert E. Wegner was born on May 29, 1933, in Saginaw, to the late Emil and Hattie (Stanko) Wegner. He married Elaine Gladys Wilt, who originated from Hemlock, on February 13, 1954. She predeceased him on June 12, 2008. He was a charter member of Messiah Lutheran Church of Carrollton Twp., where he had served on various committees. He first served in the Army National Guard from 1950 – 1952, he then enlisted in the U.S. Air Force, on Feb. 1, 1952, during the Korean War and was honorably discharged May 18, 1956. Prior to his retirement in 1991, he was employed at GM / Chevy Parts Plant for 42 years. Bob was a life member of the Carrollton / Zilwaukee V.F.W.
