Roger was called home to his Lord on Wednesday, November 24, 2021, with his family by his side. He was 91 years old. Roger Christopher Winterstein was born on June 30, 1930, in Saginaw, Michigan, son of the late Christopher and Lydia (Schultz) Winterstein. Roger married Pauline Georgia (Flohr) Winterstein on February 7, 1959, at Holy Cross Lutheran Church, and after 61 years of marriage, Pauline predeceased him on August 16, 2020.
