Tom passed away on Thursday, August 18, 2016, at home, with his family at his side, following a lengthy illness. Thomas Joseph Harvey was born on September 18, 1939, in Saginaw, to the late Francis and Marie (Simon) Harvey. He enlisted in the USMC on September 4, 1958, and was honorably discharged on September 1, 1961. During his tour of duty, he married Dianne K. Korbein on August 27, 1960, in Saginaw, where she survives him. Prior to his retirement, Tom was employed for 30 years at GM/Saginaw Steering Gear as a cutter/grinder. Tom also had worked for the Saginaw Township Schools food service, delivery, and as a playground supervisor (2000 – 2004).
