



Thomas A. Neumeyer

Tom passed away on Thursday, September 12, 2024, at MyMichigan Medical Center-Saginaw. He was 76 years old. Tom was born on July 14, 1948, in Bay City, to the late Alvin and Esther (Hammerbacher) Neumeyer.

Tom was married to Judy (Ranke) Neumeyer on January 24, 1970, she survives him.
