Tim passed away on Monday, September 7, 2020, at Covenant Medical Center – Harrison at the age of 81. Timothy James Hanlon was born on January 26, 1939, in Saginaw, MI, to the late Guy and Bessie Hanlon. Tim was married to Linda Sue (nee Smith) on May 15, 1991, in Saginaw, MI. She survives him. Tim is also survived by his stepsons, Todd Reaman (wife Sara) of Barton City and Chad Reaman (wife Kathryn) of Birch Run. Tim has three granddaughters, Hannah, Emma, and Alivia and two grandsons, Logan and Robert, who he adored and loved. Tim loved his many cats. He enjoyed sitting on his swing, watching the multitude of wildlife and birds, which he fed and cared for. Tim was predeceased by his mother, Bessie, his father, Guy and his sister, Susie. He was also predeceased by his sisters-in-law, Kathy Clancy and Mary Jo Walters, and his niece, Kristin Ennis.

Tim graduated from Saginaw High School in 1957. He then attended Michigan State University prior to joining the United States Army. Sgt. Timothy Hanlon enlisted in the United States Army on November 14, 1958, and was honorably discharged on February 20, 1962. He was a member of the Frankenmuth American Legion Post #150; he was also a member of the Masonic Lodge #77. Tim was employed as a supervisor through General Motors at the Chevy

Parts Plant in Saginaw until it closed. Tim then transferred to V-8 Engine in Flint. Upon his retirement from GM, Tim began work for Mike's Wrecker in Saginaw, where he remained for approximately 10 years.

Tim's memorial committal service will take place 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 19, 2020, in Pinegrove Cemetery, on Dixie Hwy, Bridgeport Twp., Michigan, with Military Honors under the auspices of the United States Army and V.F.W. Carrollton Post #1859. Due to the ongoing health crisis, distancing is suggested and masks are required. In accordance with Tim's wishes, cremation has taken place.
