Timothy James Kreuger passed away on Friday, September 24, 2021, at HealthSource Saginaw, at the age of 83 years. Tim was born on March 19, 1938, in Saginaw, to the late Charles W. and Mary K. (Burt) Kreuger. Tim received his Master's Degree in Music and Education, which lead him to St. John's Lutheran Church (2nd/Federal sts) in Saginaw, where he performed as the music director and organist for several years. He also played for several other Saginaw and surrounding area churches, and was known to play within a few fine-dining establishments. Tim was a dedicated instructor of music. He cherished his times when teaching others to play the organ and piano, there were several over the years, who studied under Tim's guidance. Tim was member of St. Matthew's Episcopal Church in Saginaw Township. He is survived by his sister Constance, extended family members and dear friends. He was also predeceased by his brother.
