“Vicky and I were twins. Since she can no longer speak for herself, I am taking this opportunity to speak for her. It is my intent to let you know how I know she is now in heaven.

On Friday, August 23 of this year, at my request, two Christian men from a local church went to Vicky’s hospital room to speak with her to make sure she knew the Bible way to heaven. She did not know, so, using the Bible, they showed her how she could know for sure heaven would be her eternal home when her life here on earth ended.

while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” Romans 5:8

b. “Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.” Romans 5:9

4. You must receive Christ as your personal Saviour!

a. “ ...but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.” Romans 6:23b

b. “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.” Romans 10:13

Vicky understood these four biblical truths, and on that Friday, August 23, she asked Jesus to be her personal Saviour. Her last breath here on earth was Sunday, September 16, 2018, and her next breath was in heaven.

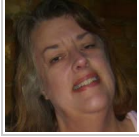
Do not delay. We have no promise of another day. Today is the day of salvation.

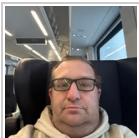
