Huber, William A. (Bill), of Zilwaukee, Michigan, passed away Tuesday morning, September 25, 2012, at his residence surrounded by his loving family. Age 86 years. Bill was born on September 18, 1926, in Saginaw, to the late Otto and Clara (Schindler) Huber. Bill served in the U.S. Army during WWII, stationed in Germany as a Medical Tech. Bill was married to Katherine (Kambourelis) Huber on July 25, 1963, in Kavala, Greece. She survives him. Prior to his retirement Bill had worked as a parts inspector at Saginaw Steering Gear for 38 years.
